Trust is the very essence of faith, trust in the God who is trustworthy. Trust is essential to human life and lies at the heart of all relationships. Trust is central to living together in harmony and so it is to be valued and honoured. At Codnor, children know that they can trust in and take inspiration from the teaching of Jesus because it guides them and helps them day by day. We care about others showing gentleness, kindness, forgiveness and honesty in all our relationships. Trust is the very essence of faith; we rely on each other to be the best that we can be. We trust God and each other and know we help to keep ourselves and each other safe.

Trust is the basis of all stable relationships, including a person's relationship with God. It is rooted in truth, and will grow through consistent experiences of reliability and integrity. God's commitment to humanity is seen in his willingness to trust ordinary people with carrying our purposes through history. Trusting God means being wholeheartedly confident in Him and His character. It means knowing He will do what He says He will do, and that He'll never act contrary to His character as disclosed in Scripture.

Noah trusted God's plan and obeyed, and God kept him safe. Time to reflect: how can God save us if we trust him?

Activity: Blindfold one child and have a partner guide them around an obstacle course, symbolising how Jesus guides us. Message: Jesus helps us navigate life, and we can trust His teachings to guide us through challenges. Time to reflect: how can Jesus help us to overcome challenges we face? *End on the Lord's Prayer
