Theme and ideas	Respect is about valuing everyone and everything and celebrating our differences. We are all God's people and we all matter. Respect involves taking responsibility for each other and speaking and interacting with others in a courteous manner. Matthew 7:12 says "Treat others as you would want them to treat you." Respect is about being honest and trustworthy. It is about looking after belongings, equipment, the school and our environment. You gain respect by giving respect. Self respect – celebrating our gifts and talents; looking after ourselves; nurturing the best we can be; honouring how God has made us; being confident about who we are; earning the respect of others. Respect for parents and carers – honouring mum and dad or those who care for us; helping at home; appreciating what's done for us; cooperation not conflict; taking responsibility Respect for those in authority – working with our elected representatives; cooperating with police, teachers and those who work for our safety in different ways; being prepared to listen and learn from others who have experience Respect for others – everyone is special; everyone's opinion matters; everyone's contribution is important; everyone's feelings should be considered; everyone's faith is sacred Respecting the environment – green issues

	Monday 28 th April	Christian Value David Respects King Saul 📖 1 Samuel 24 Story: Even though King Saul was trying to hurt David, David chose not to harm Saul when he had the chance. Instead, he showed respect for Saul's position as king. Message: Respecting others, even when they're unkind, shows strength of character.
	Tuesday 29 th April	Christian Value Jesus Respects Children 📖 Mark 10:13-16 Story: When people tried to stop children from coming to Jesus, He welcomed them warmly, blessed them, and said they were important. Message: Everyone deserves respect—especially children!

	Thursday 1 st May	Learning behaviour: Jesus Sends Out the Disciples 📖 Luke 10:1-12 Key Message: Being independent sometimes means stepping out of your comfort zone and trusting that you can do it.

	Tuesday 6 th May	Christian Value: Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet 📖 John 13:1-17 Story: Even though Jesus was the leader, He washed His friends' feet to show love and care. Message: Respect means serving others and not thinking you're better than them.

	Thursday 8 th May	Learning behaviour: Speak Up, Stand Up Story Focus: A quiet child sees someone being left out and decides to say something and include them. Key Message: Being independent means speaking up when something's not right, even if others stay silent.
