Theme and ideas	‘Learn to grow and grow to learn’ Wisdom is the knowledge and good sense we gain with experience which allows us to follow good values and make good choices. It is knowing what is right and doing it. The Bible talks of wisdom being a gift from God; Wisdom is not just about how clever someone is; it is about how we use our knowledge to make the right choices and decisions, being prepared to listen to the advice of others, thinking before you speak and choosing silence over words.		
Questions to think about:	• Is wisdom the same as intelligence? • How can we gain wisdom? • What difference will we make to others? • How can we use wisdom to affect our thoughts, words and actions and an awareness of the true value of things?		
Bible Verses	• James 1:5 - ‘If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.’ • Proverbs 1:7 - “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.” • Proverbs 2:6 - “For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding.” • 1 Corinthians 3:18 - “Do not deceive yourselves. If any of you think you are wise by the standards of this age, you should become “fools” so that you may become wise.” • Proverbs 17:28- “Even fools are thought wise if they keep silent, and discerning if they hold their tongues.” • Proverbs 19:8- “The one who gets wisdom loves life; the one who cherishes understanding will soon prosper.” • Proverbs 16:16 - “How much better to get wisdom than gold, to get insight rather than silver!”		

Bible Stories	• Solomon's Wisdom (1 Kings 3:16-28) - This story is about King Solomon, who demonstrated great wisdom when he was asked to settle a dispute between two women claiming to be the mother of the same baby. • The Wise Builder (Matthew 7:24-27) - Jesus tells a parable about two builders, one who built his house on a solid foundation of rock, and another who built on sand. The one who built on rock represents the wise person who listens to Jesus' teachings. • The Wise and Foolish Virgins (Matthew 25:1-13) - Jesus tells a parable about ten virgins who were waiting for a bridegroom. Five of them were wise and brought extra oil for their lamps, while five were foolish and did not. This story teaches us to be prepared and wise. • Daniel and the King's Food (Daniel 1:1-20) - Daniel and his friends chose to eat vegetables instead of the rich food from the king's table, and they were found to be wiser and healthier than the others. • The Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32) - While this story is primarily about forgiveness and redemption, it also shows the wisdom of the father in forgiving his wayward son. • Joseph and Pharaoh's Dreams (Genesis 41:1-36) - Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dreams about seven fat cows and seven lean cows, foretelling seven years of abundance followed by seven years of famine. Pharaoh saw Joseph's wisdom and made him a ruler in Egypt. • The Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30) - Jesus tells a story about a master who gives talents (money) to his servants. The wise servants invest and multiply their talents, while one foolish servant buries his. This story teaches about using our abilities wisely. • The Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37) - Although primarily about compassion, this story also highlights the wisdom of the Samaritan who helped a wounded man, showing kindness and care. • The Queen of Sheba and Solomon (1 Kings 10:1-13) - The Queen of Sheba visits Solomon to test his wisdom. She asks him difficult questions, and he answers them all with great wisdom, impressing her. • Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41-52) - This story tells of Jesus as a young boy who, at the age of twelve, astounds the teachers in the temple with his understanding and answers.
